(**LOS ANGELES** – Oct. 8, 2024) — The Television Academy Foundation today announced it raised over \$450,000 at the 24th Annual Emmys[®] Golf Classic. Television stars, sports luminaries, entertainment industry executives, Television Academy leadership and corporate partners competed in the golf tournament at the Riviera Country Club in Pacific Palisades, California, on Monday, Oct. 7.

The Emmys Golf Classic is a cornerstone event for the Foundation, bringing together the television community for a day of sport, networking and philanthropy. The tournament featured a putting contest and a full round of golf for participants. In addition, an afternoon pickleball competition, the "Emmys Pickleball Slam," was introduced, marking the first time the fast-growing sport was offered and creating more opportunities for attendees to network, unwind and support a worthy cause.

Proceeds from the event benefit the nonprofit's esteemed Internship and College Television Awards programs that provide industry-access and career-development opportunities for college students nationwide interested in media careers.


